Vodec Residential Phase Plan-Amended 6/25/2021

This Phase Plan will be for each Vodec group home on a home by home basis until further notice or changes have been approved by Vodec's CEO

Phase 1-Highest Risk

- No visitors allowed in the group homes
- No outing allowed for the consumers
- No home visits for consumers
- If a consumer leaves the group home with family, they will not be permitted back into the group home until it has been approved by Vodec's CEO.

Phase 2-

Residential group homes visitors

- Visitors will be limited to parents/guardians
- Visitors will schedule dates and times with the residential supervisor
- Visits will be allowed up to 1 hour per day with only one set of parents/guardians to be allowed to visit on a given day
- Visits will take place in a designated room, consumer bedroom or outside. This will need to be agreed on with the residential supervisor
- Visitors cannot visit if they are sick, have a temp over 100.4, have respiratory symptoms or have two of other known symptoms
- Visitors must bring their own thermometers if the group home does not have one to share
- Visitors will be required to wash hands upon arrival
- Visitors will be asked to social distance
- Visitors will be asked to limit their touch on any of the home's surfaces
- Visitors will be required to bring and wear a mask

Outings

- Outings can consist of outdoor activities such as social distanced games, short walks in neighborhood, vehicle rides, etc.
- Follow social distancing
- Washing hands before leaving and after getting back home

Consumers who are a resident of a Vodec group home that have been on an extended stay with family, parents/guardians since the pandemic started will be: Allowed to move back into the group home

- Once the consumer moves back into the group home, there will be no home visits until phase 4 Home visits
 - No home visits or leaving with parents/guardians

Phase 3-

Before moving onto phase 3, a time period of at least 14 days have passed since the beginning of phase 2, and there have not been any reported positive cases of Covid-19 for consumers or staff.

- Residential group home visitors
 - Visitors will be limited to parents/guardians
 - Visitors will schedule dates and times with the residential supervisor
 - Visits will be allowed up to 2 hours per day and no more than two set of parents/guardians will be allowed to visit each day
 - Visits will take place in a designated room, consumer bedroom or outside. This will need to be agreed on with the residential supervisor

- Visitors cannot visit if they are sick, have a temp over 100.4, have respiratory symptoms or have two of other known symptoms
- Visitors must bring their own thermometers if the group home does not have one to share
- Visitors will be required to wash hands upon arrival
- Visitors will be asked to social distance
- Visitors will be asked to limit their touch on any of the home's surfaces
- Visitors will be required to bring and wear a mask

Outings

- Outings can now include short trips for essential products, like grocery shopping
- Follow social distancing
- Washing hands before leaving and after getting back home
- Masks must be worn in public stores

Home visits

• No home visits or leaving with parents/guardians

Phase 4 –

Before moving onto phase 4, a time period of at least 14 days have passed since the beginning of phase 3, and there have not been any reported positive cases of Covid-19 for consumers or staff.

Residential group home visitors

- Unlimited visitors
- Visitors cannot visit if they are sick, have a temp over 100.4, have respiratory symptoms or have two of the other know symptoms
- Visitors will be required to take temperature before entering the group home
- Visitors will be required to wash hands upon arrival
- Visitors will be asked to social distance if they have not been vaccinated
- Visitors will be required to bring and wear a mask

Outings

- Outings can now include all trips essential and non-essential
- Follow social distancing rules if not vaccinated
- Wash hands before and after getting back home
- Follow mask requirements of all public places

Home Visits

- Home visits are now unlimited
- Monitoring of the consumer's temperature, respiratory symptoms and other known symptoms will be completed when the consumer comes back to the group home

Phase 5 –

All restrictions are lifted

These phase requirements are in place until further notice from Vodec's CEO. Any individual accommodations must be approved by Vodec's CEO.
